What you need to know:

Universal Credit goes live:

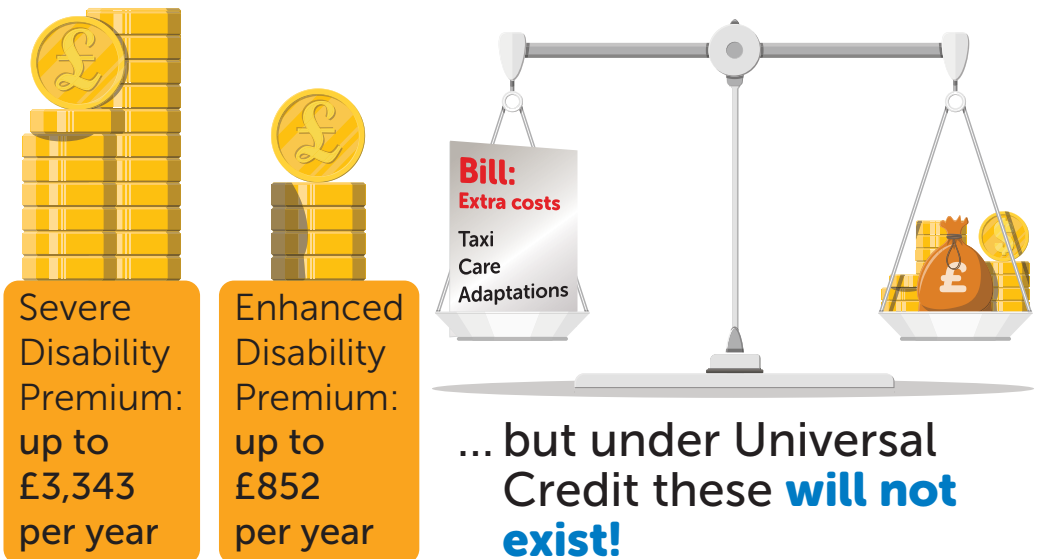
- for new claimants
- across Glasgow
- from September 2018



Everyone claiming: ESA, JSA, Housing Benefit, Tax Credits and Income Support will be gradually moved to Universal Credit by 2022, by the DWP.

At the moment:

Severe and Enhanced Disability Premiums give extra support to disabled claimants to help meet the extra costs of being disabled (e.g. taxis, bills, equipment, care costs)



So – get your premiums NOW before you are moved on to Universal Credit!

Can I claim disability premiums?

Are you: Under pension credit age?

Receiving:

- ESA and in the Support Group?
- DLA Care Component **high** rate
- PIP daily living component **enhanced** rate

You may be entitled to Enhanced Disability Premium – up to £852 per year.

Are you: A disabled Adult?

Living:

- On your own
- With someone under 18
- With someone who also gets certain disability benefits? and no-one gets Carers Allowance for supporting you?

Do you receive:

- DLA Care Component Middle or Higher rate
- PIP daily living component: standard or enhanced

You may be entitled to Severe Disability Premium – up to £3,343 per year
